Thank you for your interest in the 2022 Indiana Master Naturalist (IMN) Class being hosted by Pokagon State Park and the Steuben County Soil and Water Conservation District. Sessions begin May 3 and end June 28, 2022. The Tuesday evening sessions are from 6:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m., and there is one Saturday session. (Please see the schedule for complete details.) You must attend a minimum of eight of the nine sessions and pass the open-note quizzes with a score of at least 70% in order to qualify for certification. You must also complete 24 hours of volunteer service (at least 12 of the hours must be served in Indiana) with an environmental or natural resources organization to become certified.
