EDUCATION KITS

Our natural resource education kits contain most or all of the supplies needed to conduct a hands-on lesson. Each lesson is designed to be between 30-45 minutes (does not include clean-up time for some lessons). Educators are welcome to use the kits in their classrooms or have a member of the SWCD present to the class. Topics include erosion, food chains and food webs, pollinators, soil, stormwater, trees, the water cycle, wetlands, and worms.

AUGMENTED REALITY SANDBOX (ARS)

The Steuben County SWCD's ARS is available for use by Steuben County Educators and organization leaders (4-H, FFA, Home School Groups) to use in their classrooms or for presentations to their groups. There are lesson plans to use to supplement the classroom educational experience. The ARS combines 3D visualization with the hands on sandbox exhibit to teach earth science concepts such as topography, geography, hydrology, and much more.

2022 - 2023 Tree Seedling Order



The Indiana Division of Forestry is accepting orders for tree seedlings through May 1, 2023 (depending upon inventory) for standard spring pickup. The State Nurseries offer more than 40 species of tree and shrub seedlings to be planted in Indiana for conservation purposes (timber, windbreaks, wildlife food and habitat, watershed and soil protection, reclamation, and education). The Steuben SWCD will again offer tree pick-up for county landowners. Trees are picked up at the nursery in the spring and delivered to the SWCD Angola office. These grants provide cost-share and incentive payments to land users (i.e., landowners or long-term lease holders) to apply or construct a variety of practices on their land that reduce the amount of sediment and nutrients entering lakes /rivers (e.g., critical area plantings, hay plantings, pollinator plantings, tree plantings, grassed waterways, etc.).
